



## **BLENDED PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID**

This Paediatric First Aid elearning module allows learners to complete the full 12 hour Paediatric First Aid qualification (in line with EYFS Guidelines) as a blended course.

### **Description**

This elearning module has been designed to give learners the theoretical knowledge needed to accompany a practical face to face training day.

### **Course content will teach learners how to:**

- Be able to assess an emergency situation and prioritise what action to take
- Help a baby or child who is unresponsive and breathing normally
- Help a baby or child who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
- Help a baby or child who is having a seizure
- Help a baby or child who is choking
- Help a baby or child who is bleeding
- Help a baby or child who is suffering from shock caused by severe blood loss (hypovolemic shock)
- Help a baby or child who is suffering from anaphylactic shock
- Help a baby or child who has had an electric shock
- Help a baby or child who has burns or scalds
- Help a baby or child who has a suspected fracture
- Help a baby or child with head, neck or back injuries
- Help a baby or child who is suspected of being poisoned
- Help a baby or child with a foreign body in eyes, ears or nose
- Help a baby or child with an eye injury
- Help a baby or child with a bite or sting
- Help a baby or child who is suffering from the effects of extreme heat or cold
- Help a baby or child having: a diabetic emergency; an asthma attack; an allergic reaction; meningitis; and/or febrile convulsions
- Understand the role and responsibilities of the paediatric first aider (including appropriate contents of a first aid box and the need for recording accidents and incidents)

**Duration:** Approximately 6 hours

**Access:** This online course can be completed on any PC or mobile device. Learners can study at their own pace and log in and out as often as they wish

### **Features:**

- Appeals to all learning styles with interactive quizzes, video and audio features
- Allows learners to work at their own pace, testing their knowledge as they progress through the course

- Provides a very thorough resource for those with English as a Second Language to equip them with the vocabulary, language skills and confidence to pass a practical course
